The Seventh Session (Part-IV) of the Ninth Sikkim Legislative Assembly commenced on 19th September, 2018 at 11: 00 a.m. in the Sikkim Legislative Assembly Hall, Gangtok with the Hon'ble Speaker Shri K.N. Rai in the Chair.

All the Hon'ble Members except Hon'ble Minister Smt. Tulshi Devi Rai and the hon'ble Members Sarvashri Timothy William Basnett and Sonam Lama were present in the House.

11:00 a.m.

The Chair informed the House that the Session is being reconvened to consider urgent Government business in accordance to Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Sikkim Legislative Assembly.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

11:01 a.m.

1. Before taking up the Business of the House, the Hon'ble Speaker informed the House that Hon'ble Minister Smt. Tulsi Devi Rai, Hon'ble Members Shri Timothy William Basnett and Shri Sonam Lama had applied for leave of the House to remain absent from

the House today. Accordingly the leave was considered and granted.

OBITUARY REFERENCE

2. The Hon'ble Speaker made obituary references to the passing away of Late Shri Karma Topden, former MP, Rajya Sabha from Sikkim, Late Shri Muthuvel Karunanidhi, former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Late Shri Somnaath Chatterjee, former Speaker of Lok Sabha and Late Shri Atal Bihari Bajpayee, former Prime Minister of India.

Hon'ble Member Shri Kunga Nima Lepcha and Hon'ble Leader of the House also participated in delivering obituary references and paid tribute to the departed souls.

Thereafter, as a mark of respect to the departed souls, all the Hon'ble Members observed two minutes silence in the House.

After that the House was adjourned at 12.05 p.m and reassembled at 12.30 p.m. with the Hon'ble Deputy Speaker in the Chair.

3. to be precise and relate to the subject matter of the main Question only.

The Hon'ble Members Sarvashri R.N. Chamling and Kunga Nima Lepcha raised Supplementary Questions and were replied by the concerned Ministers.

The Hon'ble Deputy Speaker informed the House that Written answers to the Unstarred Question No. 7 & 6 of Hon'ble Member, Shri R.N. Chamling and Question No. 6 & 3 of Hon'ble Member Shri K.N. Lepcha were placed on the Table.
